Build Your Own Library

Grades 1-3

Dates & Times: June 23-26
9:30-11:30 am

In this workshop, students will build a library of their own books while exploring collaborative writing, color theory, pop-up techniques, and multi-media illustrations. We will create fun, interactive books that the students will write, illustrate and bind.

Students will make paper out of recycled materials, learning about the origins of paper with a focus on the environment. We'll look at works by artists such as Matisse and Braque, and create artwork and books from our handmade paper.

Students will be challenged to write short stories, poems, and personal narratives. Creation is the goal of this workshop, and at completion students will have several edited stories and outlets for publication.
